Central Coast Section Athletic Director Association (CCSADA) Minutes

Athletic Directors in attendance:

Meeting began at 9:00 am at the Central Coast Section Office

Introductions

1) Membership application was discussed. Art will get a PO Box and the membership form and email it to current members (people who have attended ¼ meetings). CCS and CCSADA membership will be \$45/year for an individual and \$80 for a school membership. All 12 in attendance shared who paid for that at their site—personal, school, or Booster Club. Jeff Lamb asked for money for a conference at the post CSADA board meeting in Palm Springs. CSADA wants bylaws before funding.

The September administrative workshops were discussed and the CCS staff felt it was best to continue to have three meetings to promote positive attendance. The CCS office will continue to highly publicize the CCSADA organization and push for support.

2) A 2004-2005 calendar was established:

All meetings will be held at the CCS Office with discussion of a local conference to follow.

3) Coach/Athletic Director stipends

Salary schedules were distributed from Milpitas, Gilroy, Palo Alto, Mountain View, Los Altos, and the Salinas Union High School District (4 high schools). There was discussion about combining boys' and girls' programs with one Athletic Director. Talk about money versus time. Kevin (Serra) has just become a full-time athletic director this year and he shared the process with the others. There continues to be an evolution throughout the state of release time and support for the position. Jack Daley from Gilroy had asked people to bring their information for use in his District.

4) Warren Hayashi (CSADA) recommended using CSADA bylaws with modifications and revisions where necessary. Must establish goals and objectives. Possible start up funds between \$500-\$1000. It was agreed that Chuck (EAHS) and Jack (Gilroy) would develop bylaws to be reviewed in September by the whole group.

Jean (North Salinas) discussed several Senate and Assembly bills that were discussed in Palm Springs.

SB1630 (Spier) deals with performance enhancing supplements and coaching education. In its current form it would require coaching education by 12/31/07. AB

2323 (Jackson) centers around the gender equity compliance survey. The Los Angeles survey was distributed. AB 2240 (Oropeza) is the equity in athletics bill of rights which may be required for our eligibility clearance package. AB 2404 (Steinberg) deals with discrimination in athletic programs with facilities such as cities, parks and rec. SB 1386 (Vasconcellos) is the drug and alcohol testing for high school students when you have reasonable suspicion. SB 1566 (Escutia) is the food and nutrition beverage standard that deals with sports drinks, sodas, etc. AB 858 (Goldberg) is the racial mascot act which prohibits "redskins." All of these were discussed by Roger Blake (CIF) in Palm Springs.

Lastly, Jean discussed the state conference which reinforced that athletic directors want sessions that help them do their job better.
