- B. PROPOSAL #2** To leave the total # of teams in the tournament the same, but to allow for “floaters” to qualify by power points.

The issue in Volleyball has been that the “fixed size” of each division bracket doesn’t allow for the possibility of a large amount of automatic qualifiers in any one division—eliminating any at-large, for that division, while another division doesn’t fill up. This proposal allows for some “re-allocation” of entries to another division to make sure that all 52 spots in the tournament are filled. It proposes filling those entries with at-large candidates with the next highest points and placing them in whatever division they fit. This means that Division I may end up with 14 teams, Division II with 16 and the rest with their minimum # as listed below. If the minimum # is not reached in any bracket—additional floaters will be entered by points in other divisions.

For example; one year a Division capped at 12 teams was all automatic qualifiers—no at-large were able to be entered in that division. Another year Division III did not have enough entries to fill their bracket, but Division II had several teams with respectable points left out because there were so many automatic qualifiers. The solution is to be able to “move” those entries into another division when and if that occurs.—“floaters”

**Section 3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT**

- A.** All teams will enter a single-elimination bracket format as follows:

- B.** All Automatic Qualifiers meeting the provisions of [Section 4.](#), [5.](#), and [6.](#) below are guaranteed a spot in the Tournament. **If the automatic qualifiers in any division exceeds the # of teams as listed above, that division will be expanded to accommodate such automatic qualifiers. Such action, when necessary will decrease the “floaters” that are able to be entered. (see Section 5.A.4 below)**
- C.** All matches prior to Quarter-Finals in the Tournament will be played at home sites, as specified in [Section 5.-G.](#) below.

**Section 4. QUALIFICATION OF TEAMS**

**A. ENTRIES**

The five[5]-Division Tournament brackets described in **Section 3.-A.** above, shall be comprised of the League Champion from each League; plus, one [1] additional Automatic Qualifier, in compliance with **Section 4.-B.5.A** below, from every League except the CPSAL. **The CPSAL shall only send one qualifier from each of their leagues; plus, Selected At-Large entries, and at-large “floaters” as specified in Section 4.-C. below shall be entered into the tournament. No division bracket may exceed a total of 16 teams.**

## **Section 5. SEEDING AND AT-LARGE SELECTION PROCEDURES**

The following objective criteria will be used for purposes of seeding and selecting At-Large entries:

- A. All teams wishing to enter the tournament shall be listed on the board by their league representative.**  
**(29 automatic entries, at-large entries and 4 floaters; not to exceed a total of 52 teams)**
- 1. Automatic Qualifiers will be listed by league in order of league finish. (29)**
  - 2. All other teams will be listed on the at-large board**
  - 3. Schools will be identified by their division of enrollment**
  - 4. Automatic Qualifiers and at-large teams for each division will be selected until the minimum # of teams is met for that division. If any division does not have sufficient entries to complete their minimum, an additional floater entry will be added to the tournament for each "missing" team. If any division exceeds it's minimum with automatic qualifiers, one floater entry will be removed for each such automatic qualifying team.**
  - 5. The at-large floater entries will then be selected by the use of power points to reach the total of 52 teams in the tournament. Each floater team selected shall be entered into their division of enrollment. No Division bracket may exceed a total of 16 teams.**

**RATIONALE:** As listed above. No additional cost is incurred because there are no more teams in the tournament. It allows for flexibility when a large number of the automatic qualifiers are concentrated in one or two divisions.

## **III. RECOMMENDATIONS**

- A.** Vote in favor of allowing California to experiment with the NFHS Libero rule.
- B.** Include quarter final sites in Participant Bulletin so teams understand why they are playing someone on their home court even though they may be a lower seed.
- C.** Sobrato. Milpitas and Menlo Atherton are possible future sites.
- D.** Have each form at the seeding meeting checked by the league rep and two other representatives prior to the beginning of the selection and seeding process.
- E.** League representatives should be asked to send in their league champions and automatic qualifiers to the CCS the Friday before the seeding meeting. CCS should then post those on the web page so that teams may complete their bonus points prior to coming to the meeting on Saturday.
