B. DIVING

- All divers scoring 280 in an 11-dive CCS-sanctioned or League Championship competition, or 180 in a two different six (6)-dive competitions, may enter the Section Championships.
- The six (6) optional dives performed at the CCS Championships must have a degree-of-difficulty totaling at least 10.5.
- ~~Points for diving must have been achieved in CCS-sanctioned competition.~~
- Every League or supplemental League MUST submit, along with their League entries, the names of two (2) qualified Diving judges. Five (5) names will be drawn and notified in advance of the Section

D. Entries should be submitted electronically. If absolutely impossible, entries may be submitted via fax to the ~~Meet Director~~ Results Coordinator.
