The item will then be returned to the CCS Board at its next meeting for a 2nd reading and final action.

Section 1. SCHEDULED MEETINGS

- A. Seeding: **MONDAY, MAY 01, 2006**, 6:00 PM, @ the CCS office
- B. Evaluation: **TUESDAY, MAY 30, 2006**, 4:00 PM, @ the CCS office

Section 2. TOURNAMENT DATES & TIMES

The 2006 BOYS TEAM TENNIS Championships will be conducted on:

WEDNESDAY, MAY 03; **FRIDAY, MAY 05;**
TUESDAY, MAY 09; **THURSDAY, MAY 11.**

Section 3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- B. Each team will participate in seven matches: four (4) singles & three (3) doubles.
Formats for team play:
 1. Four (4) Singles and three (3) Doubles with seven (7) team points. The format is seven (7) "best two-out-of-three sets tie-break" matches.
 2. Team Points format: Each Singles and Doubles match is worth one (1) point for a total of seven (7) points. Four (4) or more points are required to win the match.

Section 3. TOURNAMENT FORMAT (continued)

- B. 3.** *All matches shall be played to completion. Once the outcome of the team match has been decided, a shortened format may be played if both coaches and players agree. Matches still in the second set shall play a 10-point match tie break (first player to 10 points by a margin of two (2)) for the third set. Any match already in the third set shall be played to completion. A match that has not been started shall be the best of three (3) sets with a match tie-break in lieu of a third set.*

Section 9. TEAM LINE-UP AND SUBSTITUTIONS

- C.** Each team shall submit written Singles and Doubles line-ups, with alternates, at the seeding meeting and a written line-up to the opposing coach and the Site Director at every round of play. *In no instance may the first four (4) Singles players be listed as Doubles alternates.*
