4. Record against Common opponents;
5. Tournament placing;
6. Over-all record.

PROPOSAL #1: *Increase the brackets to 32 wrestlers* (10-0)

The committee feels that a number of qualified wrestlers are left out because of the limit of 29 wrestlers in each weight-class. Smaller Leagues would have the chance to qualify more wrestlers if their limit was increased from 2 to 3. Small increase in revenue would be offset by increased costs.
