Proposal #1: Allotment of Automatic qualifiers. (Passed by a vote of 6-0)

Section 4. QUALIFICATION OF TEAMS

A. ENTRIES

League Champions, plus At-Large teams to ~~will~~ fill the bracket(s). The number of League Champions (Automatic Qualifiers) allocated to each League is as follows:
 BVAL-1 2; PSAL-1; SCVAL(DeAnza) -1 2 SCCAL-1 2; TCAL-1 2; WCAL-1 2; **SCVAL(ECAL) – 1;**
BVAL(STAL) - 0

Rational: With the increase of teams in the tournament to 20, more automatic qualifiers is needed.

Proposal #2: League Classification (Passed by a vote of 6-0)

4. League Classifications

a. "B" Leagues – BVAL(MHAL); SCCAL; WCAL; SCVAL(DeAnza); TCAL; ~~PSAL~~

b. "C" Leagues – SCVAL (ECAL); BVAL(STAL)

B. AT-LARGE SELECTION, SEEDING AND BRACKETING

The following objective criteria will be used for purposes of seeding and selecting At-Large entries:

1. Point-System

LOSS	1.0	0
<u>BONUS POINTS</u>		
*# Playing a League Champion	2.0	1.0
* Being a League Champion	6.0	4.0

These bonus point values can be used a maximum of twice within League play.

* Bonus point values are to be pro-rated in case of competition with, or being, a shared-champion (example: Co-Champion = 1/2 of point value; Tri-Champion = 1/3 of point value).

Rational: Two leagues have a power league structure, thus the lower division needs to have a lower classification.
