1. All divers scoring 280 in and 11-dive CCS-sanctioned of League Championship competition, *or 180 in two (2) different six (6) dive competitions*, may enter the Section Championships.
4. *Diving preliminaries for both girls and boys will be held on Friday, May 15, 2009, with the top 20 boys and top 20 girls advancing to the finals on Sat. May 16, 2009.*

Rationale:

Since the competitors in the CCS meet must be able to complete 11 dives, having them qualify by doing 11 dives is the only way to determine if the diver is able to complete 11 different dives. This requirement will eliminate the divers who cannot complete 11 dives and possibly endanger themselves in an attempt to complete dives beyond their skill level. (Passed 6-0)
