PROPOSAL #1: (Staff): Chages in the wording in Section 6.A.3, 6.B.1.d, and 6.B.2.f

Section 6. SEEDING PROCEDURES

A. RUNNING EVENTS REQUIRING TRIAL

3. Lanes in heats will be assigned as follows: ~~4, 5, 3, 6, 2, 7, 1, 8.~~ in accordance with the NFHS rules by the games committee.

B. FIELD EVENT

1. Shot Put, Discus, Long Jump & Triple Jump:

- d. At the Section Finals, the athletes will be seeded 1 to 8 on the basis of qualifying marks, with the best competing last. Each athlete will take three [3] trials. The top eight [8] and ties (must be a fair attempt) from the trials will take three [3] final efforts in inverse order of standings at the end of the trials. Each fair attempt will be marked, and the ~~90-second~~ time-limit rule will be observed in accordance with NFHS rules

2. High Jump and Pole Vault:

- f. The ~~two-minute~~ **time limit** rule will be in effect in the high jump and pole vault, and the ~~90-second~~ rule will be in effect for the high jump. in accordance with the NFHS rules.
