VI. **ACTION ITEMS** – 2nd-Reading

A. WINTER SPORTS COMMITTEES PROPOSALS

** 1. **Basketball** – Limit each division bracket to 16-team maximum (and retain subjective criteria for teams applying for entry)

** 2. **Soccer**

a. **Expand Boys Tournament from 28 to 32 teams & Girls Tournament from 30 to 36 teams**

b. **Eliminate At-Large entries by pre-determining # of qualifiers from each League to fill the brackets, as follows:**

(Boys) "A" Leagues > 4 teams ea.; "B" Leagues > 2 teams ea.; "C" Leagues > 1 team ea.

(Girls) BVAL & SCVAL > 6 teams ea.; WCAL & PAL > 5 teams ea.; SCCAL > 4 teams;

MBL, TCAL, MTAL, WBAL & PSAL > ~~5~~ 2 teams ea.

c. **Change language, from "League Champion" & "Automatic Qualifier," to "1st Qualifier" & "2nd Qualifier," with all non-League opponents being**

d. **Establish League classifications, as follows:**

(Boys) Bay, DeAnza, Mt. Hamilton, SCCAL & WCAL > "A" Leagues;

El Camino, MBL, Ocean, Santa Teresa & TCAL > "B" Leagues;

MTAL & West Valley > "C" Leagues

(Girls) DeAnza, Mt. Hamilton, SCCAL & WCAL > "A" Leagues;

Bay, El Camino, MBL, Santa Teresa & TCAL > "B" Leagues;

MTAL, Ocean, PSAL, WBAL & West Valley > "C" Leagues

A. WINTER SPORTS COMMITTEES PROPOSALS (continued)

**** 3. Wrestling**

- a. Increase # of qualifiers in each weight-class from 29 to 32
- b. Implement point-system to seed top 4 and an alternate
- c. The # of entries per League per weight-class to be determined by the percentage of medalists over last 2 years; no League to have less than 1 entry per weight-class

**** B. ADAC PROPOSALS**

- 1. **Forfeits – Individual & Team** – Modification of CCS Bylaw Article VI (Eligibility), Section 9 (Ineligible Players) to resemble that of BVAL
- 2. **Tournament Sanctioning** – In order for a tournament hosted by a CCS member-school to be sanctioned, the format must indicate that no team will play more than double the number of contests guaranteed

**** C. SPORTSMANSHIP COMMITTEE PROPOSALS**

- 1. **Sportsmanship Contract** – Modify CCS policy so that member-schools are required to submit Sportsmanship Contracts along with eligibility lists to League Commissioners each season-of-sport
- 2. **League Sportsmanship Award** – Each League implement a Sportsmanship Award, with model to be developed by the CCS Sportsmanship Committee

VII. ACTION ITEMS – 1st-Reading

A. SPRING, '01-02 SPORTS COMMITTEES REPORTS

*** 1. Badminton**

a. Major Format Changes

- (1) Change from double-elimination format to single-elimination for the Championship bracket and double-elimination for 3rd-place, beginning in the 1st round
- (2) Adopt new USAB format (best 2-out-of-3 games to 15 points for Boys Singles and Doubles; and best 2-out-of-3 games to 11 points for Girls Singles, Girls Doubles, and Mixed doubles)
- (3) Require League Rep. to attend Seeding meeting in order for League entries to be allowed to participate
- (4) Move Tournament dates up 1 week earlier than previous years'

*** 2. Baseball**

- a. **Major Format Change** – Designate new TCAL as an "A" League, and the MBL as a "B" League

*** 3. Boys Golf**

a. Major Format Changes

- (1) BVAL, MBL, MTAL PAL, SCCAL, SCVAL, TCAL and WCAL will qualify 2 Automatic Qualifying teams; PSAL will have no Automatic Qualifiers, but would be allowed to apply for At-Large; and 6 At-Large teams selected subjectively (B-Golf Committee also submitted an alternate proposal)
- (2) Due to NCGA scheduling, Tournament dates will be moved to 1 week earlier this year only

*** 4. Gymnastics**

a. Major Format Changes

- (1) Move day of Tournament from Wednesday to Monday of same week
- (2) Modify language so that no deviation of format is allowed after publishing at the CCS Meet

*** 5. Softball**

a. Major Format Changes

- (1) Increase Tournament from 36 to 39 teams (three 13-team brackets)
(Re-submittal of previously defeated proposal)
- (2) "A" Leagues will receive 3 Automatic Qualifiers; "B" Leagues > 2 Automatic Qualifiers; "C" Leagues > 1 Automatic Qualifier

*** 6. Swimming & Diving**

- a. **Major Format Change** – Move dates of Championships to one week earlier, this year only

- * **7. Boys Tennis**
 - a. **Major Format Change** – Change language (for awarding points for playing...) from “League Champion or co-Champion” to “Automatic Qualifier”
 - * **8. Track & Field**
 - a. **Major Format Changes**
 - (1) At-Large Entries - 800, 1600 and 3200 At-Large entries to complete full field without creating extra heat
 - (2) League Entries to be submitted on disc as well as paper entry (intent is to transition to fully electronic entry system the year after)
 - (3) HJ and PV Starting Heights – Meet management to set starting heights, with no starting height to exceed the 40th percentile of League entry marks
 - * **9. Boys Volleyball**
 - a. **Major Format Changes**
 - (1) Change bonus points for being a League Champion from 6 (“A” League) and 4 (“B” League) to 9 and 6, respectively
 - (2) Add “Independent CCS opponents” to the “B” classification
 - (3) Add “rally scoring to 15 points in the 5th game” to the CCS Championships
