(The ADAC has already taken a position of **support** of this proposal.)
  - d. **Proposal #5** (Staff Proposal) – *Leagues/Divisions may nominate a maximum of four (4) teams in any one (1) Division, in order of League finish.*  
(The ADAC has already taken a position of **support** of this proposal.)
