B. SPORTSMANSHIP COMMITTEE PROPOSALS

- * **1. CCS Sportsmanship Policy** – Add the following language, effective as soon as possible:
“No coach, player or spectator shall enter the playing area, or delay the normal continuation of play, of any contest to question an official’s decision without first employing the appropriate procedure for such action, as outlined in the pertinent National Federation Rule Book. If such procedure is not followed, the offender shall be considered to have exhibited “Unsportsmanlike Conduct,” and will therefore be subject to immediate ejection from the contest, as outlined in the appropriate rules of the aforesaid-mentioned National Federation Rule Book.”
