#### \*\* B. ADAC PROPOSALS

1. Basketball – Would require all teams wishing to enter the Tournament to meet at least one of the following criteria:
  - Be a League Champion; OR
  - Be a League Runner-Up; OR
  - Have a League record of at least .500; OR
  - Have a *non-League* of at least .500; PLUS
  - *Eliminate* the waiver process by which a team with none of the four criteria above being able to petition its League to enter the Tournament.
- 1a. (WCAL Amendment) – If the above proposal (to which the WCAL is opposed) is approved, then the date of implementation will be the 2005-06 season, rather than 2004-05.

#### \*\* C. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE PROPOSALS

1. Wrestling Weigh-ins – Would modify CCS Bylaws **Article VIII. (Equal Opportunity and Access), Section 6. (Wrestling Weigh-Ins) (new)**, regarding male/female wrestlers and weigh-masters.

**\*\* D. STAFF PROPOSALS**

1. **Ass't. Commissioner's Duties** – Would modify CCS Bylaws **Article I. (Duties of Officers), Section 4. (Assistant Commissioner) (new)**, to stipulate that the Ass't. Commissioner shall be an officer of the CCS, assuming the position of Secretary.

**VII. ACTION ITEMS – 1<sup>st</sup>-Reading**

**A. SPRING, '03-04 SPORT COMMITTEES REPORTS**

- \* 1. **Badminton**
  - a. **Major Format Change** – Change back to a *full double-elimination* format, rather than the present format of a single-elimination for the Championship bracket and double-elimination for 3<sup>rd</sup>-place, beginning in the 1<sup>st</sup> round
- \* 2. **Baseball**
  - a. **Major Format Changes**
    - (1) Would provide opportunity for any team to opt to Division I if either of the following criteria is achieved:
      - Qualify as one of top eight (8) qualifying teams, under current CCS point-system; OR
      - Be an "A" League Champion.
    - (2) Change the maximum number of contests from 24 to *30, counting game-for-game.*
    - (3) **(PAL Proposal)** – Change classification of the PAL's Bay, Ocean and Lake Divisions from "B," "B" and "C" to *"A," "B" and "C,"* respectively.
- \* 3. **Boys Golf**
- \* 4. **Gymnastics**
  - a. **Major Format Changes**
    - (1) Modify **Section 3. (Qualifying Criteria for CCS Meet)**, as follows:
      - Teams must score *160.00 or better*, rather than 150.00, and it must be achieved at the *League Finals*, rather than any official school meet;
      - Individual qualifiers must meet *new standards* at their League Finals in all events.

- \* 8. **Track & Field**
  - a. **Major Format Changes**
    - (1) At-Large Entries – Adjust the number of entrants qualifying from Leagues to the top *12* marks, rather than the top eight (8).
    - (2) *Leagues not providing personnel 30' prior to pre-assigned duties at Section Meet will be fined \$100; OR*
    - (2a) **(Staff Proposal)** – *Leagues not providing personnel 30' prior to pre-assigned duties at Section Meet will forfeit one (1) qualifier in each event the following year.*
