This process allows other leagues to fill in the 29 person bracket at the section meet when a league cannot fulfill their allocated slots.

This process involves the collection of information of the wrestler(s) from your league who do not qualify directly into the CCS tournament through your allocated slots.

Procedures at meeting:

1. Each league bring 15 copies of each wrestler per weight submitted as a fill in
2. Each league representative will present their candidate, no discussion, just clarifying questions.
3. After all candidates are presented each league representative will vote on sheet.
4. The candidates will be ranked according to highest points to lowest points
5. If there is a tie for any position a vote will be taken to break the tie-this can be a hand vote.
6. The committee will be informed of the rankings before leaving the meeting to inform the athletes if they may get into the tournament.
7. Remember an athlete may not know if they are in the tournament until after weigh ins-it is a good idea for the top four vote candidates make weight and wait for the results on Friday morning.

An example would be:

- League A has 4 automatic qualifiers
- League A should wrestle for the 5th slot since that wrestler would be eligible as the fill in slot.
- If one of League A's automatic qualifiers cannot compete then the 5th place wrestler should move into one of League A's automatic slots.
- Then the 6th place wrestler would be the eligible wrestler for the fill in slot
- The 5th and 6th place wrestler in the League A should fill out the attached form.

This example you can apply to your leagues since many of you have different numbers of automatic qualifiers.

Please have the wrestler or coach fill out the attached information form and have the league representative bring it to the CCS Seeding Meeting for evaluation and vote of the committee.
