SUBJECT: CCS REALIGNMENT PROCESS

According to the CCS Bylaws Article IV League Realignment, the 2002-2003 school year is one in which we will be addressing League Realignment.

You should review the attached CCS Bylaws, Article IV if your school has an interest in pursuing a change in league placement.

The Realignment Committee did not receive any requests or proposals for changes to conference membership and have recommended to the CCS Executive Committee that conference membership remain status quo. The Executive Committee will review that at their next meeting. We anticipate approval of our recommendation. Listed below is the current league/conference membership.

Our next step will be for each conference to meet with their respective chairperson. Each league should select a representative from their league to sit on their respective conference realignment committee. These committee meetings will be scheduled by the Conference Chairs and will be held no later than the first full-week in February.

If you have league realignment issues or proposals, please begin formulating those, so that they are ready to be presented when your respective Conference Realignment Committee meets. If there are no requests or proposals for change at the first meeting, the Conference Realignment Committee may develop their own proposals or recommend no changes to the Conference.

I realize that we made some major realignment changes in the last cycle that are just taking effect this year. However, it is important for any realignment concerns to be raised this year. Any changes made during this cycle would go into effect 2004-2005. Following this cycle, our next opportunity to address basic league structure will be in the 2004-2005 school year for changes that would not go into effect until 2006-2007.
