Any Central Conference member school who wishes to attend this meeting or present a proposal to the committee for consideration is welcome to do so. It is anticipated that the Advisory Sub Committee will review all the proposals that are presented that day to the Committee or sent to them via the mail prior to the meeting. The Advisory Sub Committee may decide to host additional meetings based upon what proposals are received or generated by the Committee itself.

The Committee may hold as many meetings as is necessary between this first week in February and the first week in March when they are required to make a final recommendation. After that, a meeting of the entire Conference (one vote per school) will be scheduled to discuss and vote upon any proposed changes to any of the basic leagues in the Central Conference. (this meeting will be held the fourth week in March)

- ALL INTERESTED PARTIES should plan to attend this meeting as noted above.
- ANYONE INTERESTED IN SUBMITTING A PROPOSAL for basic league alignment should either mail a copy of such proposal to me **at 3200 Senter Road, San Jose CA 95111** or bring 10 copies of any proposal to the meeting. Any proposals submitted to this Committee for consideration must be in writing and must address a total plan for any leagues and/or schools in the conference affected by their request for change in league affiliation.
